

Charter of the Free Nations League

“Freedom and Independence”

The Free Nations League

- Based on the right of peoples and territories to liberation from colonial dependence,
- Affirming the internationally recognized right of nations to self-determination,
- Acknowledging the principle of equal rights for both large and small nations as enshrined in international documents,
- Recognizing the importance of preventing and eliminating threats to the existence of humanity, maintaining international security, and suppressing any acts of aggression or other breaches of peace,
- Guided by the belief that the observance, promotion, and protection of the rights of not only individuals but also of peoples are essential concerns for the international community,
- Reaffirming our commitment to the goals and principles of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and other international documents, while asserting the necessity of improving them in the interests of peoples, nations, and all of humanity,

The Free Nations League declares the following:

I. Our Goals:

1. To achieve freedom by all peoples oppressed by Russia.
2. To secure international legal and political recognition, expand rights, and elevate the status of peoples under colonial dependence.
3. To establish new independent democratic states based on the territories of ethnic republics, other ethnic formations, and regions within the Russian Federation.
4. To attain international recognition of these new independent democratic states.
5. To pursue the de-imperialization and decolonization of the Russian Federation, including the dissolution of Russia in its current format, with the complete eradication of any

conditions or factors that might lead to the revival of a viable successor to the current Russia. The League of Free Nations announces the rejection of nuclear weapons across all territories and demands the complete denuclearization of all Eurasia.

II. Our Fundamental Political Principles:

1. Russia is a colonial empire that maintains peoples and territories in colonial dependence through force. Through violence, deceit, and bribery, Moscow has seized our peoples and annexed their historical territories, destroying their former states and state structures, and depriving these peoples of the opportunity for independent development. Russia is an aggressor state, committing mass killings, sponsoring international terrorism, and posing a threat of nuclear war.
2. Each ethnic republic and region within the Russian Federation is considered a state.
3. Each ethnic republic and region has the right to secede from the Russian Federation and establish an independent state.
4. The right of our peoples to secede from the Russian Federation is unconditional. The liberation of nations from colonial dependence does not require a referendum, just as a referendum on human rights is impossible under an authoritarian repressive regime. All ethnic republics possess the necessary sovereignty to secede from the Russian Federation and declare sovereign independent statehood.
5. Every indigenous people residing within the territory of the Russian Federation has the unconditional right to self-determination. Every people oppressed by Moscow has the right to struggle for freedom and independence, including through armed resistance.
6. All nations, republics, and regions have the right to determine their own future independently.
7. Based on the principle of the presumption of subjectivity, nations, republics, and regions that choose the path of independence do not need to appeal to anyone or anything for permission to be granted state sovereignty, regardless of whether the current political regime in the Russian Federation collapses or is replaced by another regime.
8. The principle of the supremacy of international law over national law is recognized.

III. Our Values:

1. Freedom and democracy
2. Respect for, observance of, and protection of human and peoples' rights and freedoms
3. Adherence to international legal norms and a commitment to their continual improvement
4. The final eradication of all extreme forms of colonial rule
5. Peace and mutual respect among nations
6. Dignity and responsibility
7. Unyielding opposition to oppression and the violation of freedom and universal human values

IV. Every member of the Free Nations League must understand and share the values, principles, and rules that guide the organization.

V. The formation of any state unions is possible only by the will of the new independent states.

VI. We belong to different peoples, cultures, and religions, but to a single human civilization. We may hold different political views, but we firmly reject racism, chauvinism, and xenophobia. We respect each other's right to hold opinions and beliefs that differ from our own. We recognize the right of new independent states to choose their own path of development and commit to fully supporting one another in the pursuit of freedom and independence, fostering cooperation, and maintaining transparency in our intentions.

VII. Our ideological and political opponents are those who advocate for imperial, authoritarian, and totalitarian positions, who deny the necessity of the de-imperialization and decolonization of the Russia, who seek to preserve the empire and authoritarian rule in any form, including pseudo-democratic, or who are willing to collaborate with Russia, as well as supporters of totalitarianism.
